Order:

After the verification of the description of the factors above in the supporting documents RNS Vidyaniketana Murdeswar Bhatkala-Taluk (UK) has been granted the renewal of recognition of 1st to 7th standard with the below conditions from 2020-21 to 2022-23 with permanent without aid.

Conditions :

1.As the school is permanently unaid, the wage and allowance of primary school staff should be totally maintained by the management permanently.



2. The school must follow all the rules in Karnataka Education Institutions (Primary and High School Recognition) Rules 1999 crafted under Karnataka Education Act 1983.
3. Students minimum enrollment limit must be maintained.
4. To run the school without a permanent grant.
5. Appointment of appropriately trained faculty at the school.
6. The Management shall provide minimum salary and other benefits to the employees as per rules regarding Teacher Service Facilities.
7. Every year medical examination should be done in accordance with regulations.
8. To start the school, the management should keep a security deposit in the Joint account of concerned Deputy Director and the management.
9. Providing separate toilets for Girls and boys.
10. The Management shall take care of the safety of the children.
11. Fire extinguishers must be implemented; utter care must be taken to avoid keeping fire catching materials and poisonous things. The Kitchen must be in pucca building. The school building must be as per criteria. Essential precautions action must be taken of all school buildings as per National Building Code of India 2005.
12. The primary School should have sufficient number of teaching aids and furniture according ratio of students.
13. It is subject to condition to get the exemption within 6 months for the minimum number of students from Deputy Director (Administration).

Conditions :

1. Maintain minimum enrollment/ Attendance limit of students assigned for each class.
2. The high school should have appropriate trained teaching and non-teaching staff and the appointments should be made as per Government reservation rules.





3. As per Government Order Date: 19-06-99 the management should provide basic amenities, Own Building and playground compulsorily
4. The High School should have sufficient number of teaching aids and furniture according ratio of students.
5. To comply with the mandates and circulars of the Government Department which change from time to time by the Management and the school staff.
6. Karnataka Private Education Institutions (Accredited by Primary and Secondary Education Institutions) Act 1999 created under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 shall adhere to the rules.
7. The provisions of the Department of 1983 of Act 1 of Education Act 1995 and the rules from time to time should be strictly adhered.
8. Girls and boys should have toilet and water facility separately.
9. The Management shall take care of the safety of the children.
10. Implementation of fire extinguishers in school for the safety of students and to provide periodic training to all staff on its use from time to time.
11. The school should employ qualified teachers who have studied in the medium in which medium of instruction is permitted and must have qualifications as per rules and minimum wage / service security as set by the government should be provided.
12. The school should be in suitable building and should have plenty of room.
13. The approved building should have design and safety as designated by the Department of Public Works. Essential precautionous action must be taken of all school buildings as per National Building Code of India 2005.
14. If any of the above conditions are violated, this office shall have the authority to take further action in accordance with the department's wishes.
15. The CC Camera is mandatory in the school for the safety of school children.
16. Regulation of PTRs.
17. Government Circular No: EP 46 SH 2020 dated: 10-11-2020 strictly adheres to all directions of school safety precautions and is bound to submit certificates to this office within 15 days from relevant authorities as per the said circular.
